Weir, Ltd., Glasgow, attend at their works on the 27th August, 1943 and subsequently for the purpose of examining and witnessing tests on One 6" x 5½" x 15" Fire & Bilge Pump manufacture by them under Job No. 171820 to the order of Messrs. C.D. Holmes & Co. Ltd. Engine No. 1661.

Satisfactory hydraulic tests of 400 lbs per sq.inch were made on the steam cylinder and 200 lbs per sq.inch on the pump end, and the following results were obtained under working conditions:-
