Weir Ltd., Glasgow attend at their works on the 19th May, 1943 for the purpose of examining and witnessing tests on one 4" x 6" x 12" Boiler Feed Pump manufactured by them under Job No. 171836 to the order of Messrs. C. D. Holmes & Co. Ltd., Engine No. 1661.

Satisfactory hydraulic tests of 400 pounds per square inch were made on the steam cylinder and 400 pounds per square inch on the pump end and the following results were obtained under working conditions:-
