## "LUCIA 2"

Herewith please find tonnage computation for the above vessel, calculated, in the absence of a copy of the Panamanian Regulations, in accordance with The Merchant Shipping Act, from measurements now taken. It would appear that the fee chargeable by M.O.W.T. scale is £6.

The vessel is leaving this port on Saturday, 20th. July for Rouen where the tanks are to be specially coated for the carriage of wine in bulk, and the Special Survey advanced by the testing of the After peak and oil fuel bunkers. The only other outstanding item for survey is the internal examination of the Oil Fuel Bunkers and in view of the age of the vessel it is a matter for special consideration whether this internal examination should be insisted upon.

We also enclose Rpt.C.12(c) and copy of Provisional Freeboard certificate in duplicate, the conditions of assignment set forth in the letter of 4th. July having been complied with. First Entry and Special Survey reports and copy of Interim Certificate will be forwarded tomorrow and we should be glad to know what fees should be charged in respect of all the surveys. Please forward photostatic copy of Tonnage calculations for our records in Cardiff Office.

## "CHANT 6"

We are informed by the Owners' Representative as per copy of letter attached that this vessel is being sold and that the surveys requested are not now required.

Our reports covering the work done up to cancellation date will be forwarded in due course and we shall be glad to know what fees should be charged in this case.
