

M.S. "KANLAON"

The name of this vessel has always appeared in the American Official List as "KANLAON II" and in the American Record and Lloyd's Register Book as "KANLAON". Incidentally the gross and net tonnages given in the American Official List are 477 and 211 respectively.

There also appears in the American Official List and American Record a steamer named "CANLAON", 667 gross tons, and owned by the Philippine Government, and it is not unknown that when vessels have a similar name (although not identical) the symbol "II" has been added in the cases of Philippine vessels.

In all the circumstances I think the "KANLAON II" referred to in Lloyd's Agents letter of the 29th January, '35, is the "KANLAON" in Lloyd's Register Book, and perhaps further inquiry may be considered necessary so that the discrepancy can definitely be cleared up.
