With reference to the Glasgow first entry report No.39850 on the three boilers No.412 made by Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Ltd., I have to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough report that these boilers have been fitted into the s.s. "WAR PICTURE" (now named "DALMAZIA"), Messrs. The Furness Shipbuilding Co's No.16 vessel.

Accounts have to-day been rendered to the Accountant General, Ministry of Shipping, for the fees due for the survey during construction of the hull and machinery of this vessel, and on payment, £36:6:4 will be credited to your port for the survey during construction of the Boilers.
