I am in receipt of your letter of the 6th instant, enclosing copies of communications in connection with the question of the limits of service etc., of the above ship, and the contents have been noted.

I shall, however, be glad if you will inform the Owners that as the scantlings and arrangements of this vessel do not comply with the Society's requirements for an unrestricted service, it will be necessary for the trading limits to be defined before a class can be assigned, and I shall be glad if you will again confer with the Owners with a view to suitable coasting limits being stated. I think it well to add that the type of notation may be "Coasting service, Marseilles to Cadiz" or similar limits.
