Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in -

The temporary accommodation in the No. 4 & 5 'tween decks has been dispensed with and the port side companion deck apperture giving access closed by means of a welded 5/16" steel plate. Both the port and starboard companion casings have been retained, the port casing now being used as a store room for spare gear whilst the door of the starboard casing has been secured in the closed position by means of wood battens.

In addition all W.C.'s and washbasins have been removed from the 'tween deck and the shell appertures serving these permanently closed by welded spigot plates to provide a flush surface.
