I have to acquaint you that to complete the Boiler Survey which became due at the end of April last, and to entitle the vessel to a record of "BS.4,40", the safety valves require to be adjusted under steam, and I shall be glad to learn what arrangements the Owners propose making for this matter to receive attention.

I think it well to add that a proposal to carry out the 2nd Special Survey No.1 some time before the expiration of the Year of Grace, in June next, has been agreed to.
