The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.



The 2nd Special Survey No. 1 becomes due 6.40, and a proposal to take advantage of the year of grace has been agreed to, subject to a General Examination and a favourable report.

The Gothenburg Surveyors now report the vessel generally examined afloat and found in satisfactory condition, and the Surveyors recommend postponement of the Survey until some time within the year of grace.

It is submitted, *this recommendation be concurred in and that* the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey as recommended.

The Certificate of Classification to be issued "Large Tonnage" and the same notation to be printed in the Register Book.
