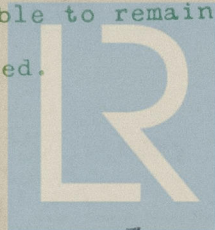
This trawler, built in 9.43, holds the notation of 100A- "Steam Trawler" for Government Service.

The Middlesbrough Surveyor states that on account of explosion in starboard bunker adjacent to stokehold he has made an examination and found no damage was sustained in stokehold. Steam pipes and electrical installation examined and safety valves adjusted.
