Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter ref. M of the 8th Inst., regarding the freeboard of the barge "SAUVETEUR N°7", we have to confirm that the freeboards on the vessel are those assigned by the Board of Trade when the vessel was built.

After consultation with the Owner's Representative we have to inform you that assignment by this Society in accordance with French regulations is not now desired. The vessel is to be employed in salvage operations, for the stowage of salvage gear or cargo discharged, for the purpose of lightening, from vessels being salvaged on the coast of France from say, Cherbourg, northwards.
