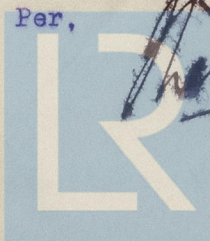
As to the character for equipment they are considering the expense involved in testing the anchors and chains and we shall advise you as to whether the equipment character should be included in the class.
