"SAUVETEUR N°7" ex "MAANTEEL"

Dear Sir,

We beg to submit herewith plans of midship section and profile of the Barge "SAUVETEUR",^{N°7} which vessel, our friends the Cie de Remorquage et de Sauvetage "LES ABEILLES", Le Havre desire to have classed.

She has been acquired for use in connection with salvage operations such as, for example, when the vessel being salvaged requires to be lightened and her cargo or equipment has to be placed in barges such as the one now submitted.

She is stated to have been built in 1911 by Messrs J. Scarr & Son, Howden. Her official number according to a Board of Trade certificate found aboard is N°132274 and her dimensions closely approach those of the Steamer "YENDIS" N°38797 in R.B. built by the same builders and at about the same time.

Another similar vessel, the SAUVETEUR 4 N° 05901 was recently acquired by the Havre firm mentioned above.

The SAUVETEUR N°7 was evidently built as a Steamer but no machinery now exists aboard and the stern tube has a blank flange fitted on it in way of the boss.
