my satisfaction.* Jasud Quare.

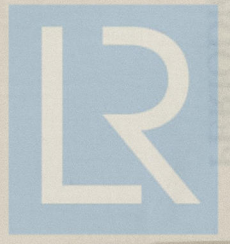
