

FREEBOARD.

Application for Certificate of Approval of the Position of the Centre of the Disc, and of the Lines to be used in connexion therewith, under the provisions of the International Load Line Convention, 1930.

Application is hereby made to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping for a certificate of approval of the position [or alteration of the position] of the centre of the disc and of the lines to be used in connexion therewith on the steam ship (sailing ship) Mont Agel Official No. 28876 which is not classed in Lloyd's Register Book. It is not intended to carry timber deck cargoes. It is not intended to carry liquid cargoes in bulk.

No previous application has been made either by the builder or the owner for a certificate of approval of the position [or alteration of the position] of the centre of the disc on this ship to this or any other authority appointed in accordance with the Merchant Shipping [Safety and Load Line Conventions] Act, 1932 (except in pursuance of a previous certificate, dated 26 May 1920 which has expired, or which has not yet had effect).
