We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 136 building by Messrs. Mitsui Bussan Kaisha Yama Yard for Messrs. Rising Sun Petroleum Oil Co. Ltd. of 50. Tons. Length 72'-0" Breadth 16'-0", Depth 5'-9" intended to be Classed ~~100~~+A 1, "Barge Carrying Buzio in Bulk For Service in the Inland Sea of Japan".

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.
