QUESTION.

Reverting to my enquiry of the 20th September and your reply of the 6th November last, I think it well to inform you that this vessel broke adrift during a typhoon in the night of 3/4th April last, and it is stated that the engine room and pump room were flooded.

As no further information has come to hand, I shall be glad if you will kindly inquire and let me know whether she has been refloated, repaired and replaced in commission or abandoned as a total loss by all concerned.

If a total loss, particulars of her voyage and cargo will be appreciated, if readily obtainable, for purposes of the Society's Wreck Returns.
