Dear Mr. Scott:

With reference to your letter of the 2d ultimo, and to Newport News Report 1588 on the steamer "H.M. FLAGLER", I enclose herewith a letter dated the 27th ultimo received from the Surveyors from which it will be seen that the floors in the double bottom are fitted as approved; that back bars are fitted to shell lugs on the transverses in way of the oil tanks as shown on the approved plans; that the chain cables were examined and found to be in accordance with certificates Nos. 254 & 256 issued from the Societys' Detroit office May 4, 1917, and that these chain cables were tested at a machine recognized by the Committee .
