Dear Sir:-

In reply to your letter dated 10th instant regarding the freeboard report on the S.S. "H. M. FLAGLER", I have to inform you that (1) Under deck tonnage measurements to shelter deck is 8103 tons; (2) Registered depth to shelter deck is 35.28'; (3) Breadth of shelter at amidships is 58.5'; (4) Measurement in way of ballast tanks for and aft was taken to the assumed floor line of 3'.

The tonnage of the peaks is included in the above under-deck tonnage to shelter deck.
