Reason of Survey held, &c.,

The 3rd S.S. No. 1, due 7.39, was completed in October 1939 except that the hold in way of sand ballast requires to be examined and a hand pump fitted for the suction in fore peak.

A proposal to complete the Special Survey on discharge at Buenos Aires was agreed to.

In reply to enquiry, the Stockholm Surveyors now write they are informed by the Owners the vessel is lying at Kristiansand and there is no possibility, owing to the circumstances, to have her put into commission in a reasonably near future.

The Owners state, however, that the outstanding items of survey and repairs will be attended to before re-commissioning.

Kristiansand is a port in enemy occupation.

The year of grace expired 7.40.
