
Dear Sir:-

I have to acknowledge your letter of November 8th. with further reference to your previous letter of October 2nd, and my reply of October 16th. on the Sailing Ship "MOSHULU", and the fees and expenses paid to Mr. Knox covering May 28th. to May 31st, 1935.
