I have to inform you that in dealing with the returns received from the Society's Surveyor at Vancouver recently it was observed that he had forwarded vouchers for fees and expenses which he had paid to Mr. R. Knox, for services in connexion with the survey of the sailing ship "MOSHULU" at Victoria on the 28th, 29th, 30th and 31st May last.

Mr. Scott was asked in what circumstances Mr. Knox's services were required, and I enclose a copy of the letter that I have received from him in explanation of the circumstances.
