
Dear Sir:-

I have to acknowledge your letter of October 2nd. with reference to Vancouver Report No. 4006 on the Steel Sailing Ship "MOSHULU", and drawing attention in connection therewith, to the vouchers forwarded with our returns showing a fee of \$40.00 and \$31.00 expenses paid to Mr. R. Knox in connection with the survey of this vessel at Victoria on May 28, 29, 30 and 31st.

The survey for classification on the "MOSHULU" commenced on dry dock May 28th., and was continued on May 29, 30 and 31st.

I also had a survey at Victoria on the Cables ship "RESTORER", including uptakes and inner funnel.

Surveys were also held on these days at Victoria on the Barge "FIBREBOARD" and the Auxiliary Arctic Schooner "ST. ROCH", which was undergoing Special Survey.


