"KAIONE" I have to acknowledge the receipt of your memorandum of the 5th ultimo intimating that this vessel still continues to be laid up and the Committee note that she is well looked after by the Harbourmaster's staff and that you have suggested that it would be in the Owners' interests to arrange for a dry docking owing to the underwater portions being in a neglected state.

With regard to this case I may say that as the vessel still continues to be laid up, from the classification point of view, there will be no objection to the dry docking being deferred to suit the Owners' convenience, but of course it must be distinctly understood that the Second Special Survey No.1 which became due in April, 1935, must be completely held before the vessel is placed in commission.
