With reference to the classing addressed to you on the 19th inst, I shall be glad to learn this vessel is still laid up.

This vessel is still laid up moored to the wharf at Castlecliff in front of the Harbourmaster's Office and it is well looked after everywhere by the Harbourmaster's staff and the Harbour Board's Chief Mechanical Engineer.

However, the underwater portions obviously are neglected. In my private capacity I frequently act as the engineer adviser to the Owners, the Wanganui Harbour Board, who have not had an engineer for a number of years. I told the Managing Secretary, some months ago, that he should bring the "Kaione" down to this port and drydock her for bottom cleaning and painting and he promised to ask his Board to do it next year. She has been in the market for sale or charter for several years.
