Nature of Survey

When due

A Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's Agent at Wellington N.Z. reported in December last that the S.S.No.1 had been held but further information was required regarding alterations which appeared to have been carried out in way of the forepeak and it was not clear whether the deep tank had been tested.

From a letter now received from the Surveyor it would appear the alterations consisted of the permanent closing of an opening in the shell plating on each side forward in way of a steering propeller trunkway, this propeller having been removed.

The deep tank is not now used for ^{water} ballast.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 12,22 and notation of S.S.Wln No.1-22.
