Fleming & Ferguson Ltd's S.S. No.429) while being moved from her mooring berth in the River Cart on the 23rd December, 1915.

Recommended

that the Port and Starboard Tail Shafts, Propellers and Sea connection fastenings, be examined.

Found.

1 Blade of the Starboard Propeller broken off about 12" from the tip. A new propeller has now been fitted.

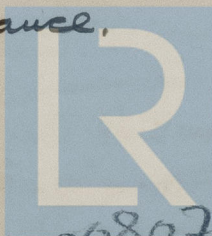
The above recommendations were made so as to place the vessel in the same good and efficient condition as before the damage took place.
