A SPECIALS URVEY (C) became due 6,53. Postponement until 6,54 approved.

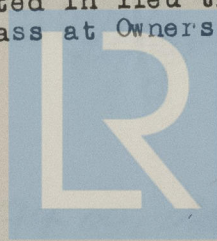
ACTION is DEFERRED for Special Survey on ship's arrival at an Italian port from present voyage by 7,54.
