the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. "A/S. D/S. Myren" survey the steamer "CLARA", 1398 Tons gross of Copenhagen, formerly classed with the Germanischer Lloyd on the 3rd of January, 1947, and that the following parts of hull and machinery were examined afloat,

Hull:- Weatherdecks, tweendecks, hatchways, ventilators, deck-houses, windlass, steering gear, holds, peaks, bunkers and engine- and boiler space.

Machinery:- External examination of machinery, and that I have recommended to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London that the vessel be assigned a Record of "Examined L.R. 1.47" in the Register Book, indicating that, from the parts seen, she appears to be in an efficient condition for a period of 12 months from 3rd January, 1947, subject to drydocking and boiler survey being held at the first opportunity. (The vessel being fit to carry dry and perishable cargoes. Cargo battend not fitted).
