Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 2nd instant enclosing a copy of one addressed to the Coaster Construction Co., Ltd., respecting the equipment of their S.S.No.117, and have to inform you that the contents have been carefully noted.

In reply thereto I am directed to state that in view of the very restricted service of the vessel, but bearing in mind the fact that she is to proceed to New Zealand under her own steam, the equipment previously approved will be accepted for the figure 1 in this instance, subject to one of the  $12\frac{1}{2}$  cwt. bower anchors being replaced by one of  $14\frac{1}{2}$  cwt. and that the stud chain cable being increased to  $1\text{-}3/16$ " in diameter as required by the Rules.
