A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 2,52.

The year of grace expires 2,53.

This ship was generally examined in dry dock 7,52 preliminary to carrying out the Special Survey when it was found a considerable amount of renewals to deck, shell plating, etc. would be necessary for class maintenance.

The Owners stated it was not their intention to carry out the Special Survey, and that the ship would proceed in ballast to the U.K. thereafter to be employed within harbour limits as a stowage ship.

ACTION is DEFERRED for further enquiry.
