Dear Sirs,

II. I duly received your letter of the 7th instant respecting the Steam Trawler "FOSSUR", and with regard thereto I have to inform you that the vessel was built in 1906 and was classed "LOCAL Steam Trawler". Her class was expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line in January 1949.

To entitle the vessel's character to be reinstated in the Register Book it will be necessary for the requirements of a Periodical Special Survey (C) to be complied with and for the plating to be drill tested as necessary.

Any major repairs which have been effected to the structure of the vessel since being disclassed will require to be specially examined in order to ascertain the character of the workmanship and to ensure that the materials used are in accordance with the Rules. Any structural alterations which may have been carried out since the vessel's class lapsed, and which affect the longitudinal and/or transverse strength of the vessel should be reported in detail.

To enable the figure '1' to be reinstated full particulars of the equipment on board will require to be furnished.

As regards the machinery, a complete Special Survey of the machinery and boiler should be held. The screwshaft was last examined in August 1947 and this survey need not be held now as part of the Reclassification Survey.
