

'FOSSUR'

This vessel was built by Cochrane & Sons of Selby in 1906 and was classed ~~LOCAL~~ 100A1 Stm Trawler.

The vessel's character was withdrawn from the Register Book in January 1949 and a red line (—) inserted in lieu, indicating non-compliance with the Rules regarding surveys.

The KIEL Surveyor states in a letter dated 7.3.50 that the Owners may apply for Reclassification.

In order to have her character reinstated in the Register Book, it will be necessary for the requirements of a Periodical Special Survey (C) to be complied with, and the plating drill tested as deemed necessary.

Any major repairs which have been effected to the structure of the vessel since being disclassed will require to be specially examined in order to ascertain the character of the workmanship, and that the materials used are in accordance with the Rules.

Structural alterations which may have been carried out since the vessel's class lapsed, and which affect the longitudinal and/or transverse strength of the vessel should be reported in detail.

In order that the figure '1' can be reinstated, full particulars of the equipment on board will require to be furnished.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Surveyors be informed accordingly.
