Steam Trawler "FOSSUR"

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant, the contents of which have been duly noted.

With regard thereto, I think it well to explain that the survey held by Mr. Vilhelm Nielsen at Thorshavn last month was confined to the rewelding of the starboard furnace, and subsequent testing of the boiler. The survey did not therefore, comprise the full requirements of Boiler Survey as required by the Society's Rules, and as this survey became due so long ago as January last, it is requested that you will make early arrangements for the boiler to be opened up and examined in accordance with the full requirements for this survey.

Similarly, I think it well to explain that the Periodical Special Survey (C) required in my letter of the 19th March last, will comprise, in addition to the items reported by the Society's Surveyors at Leith in September 1947, a complete opening up and examination of the vessel as required for Special Survey. As the limit of time in regard to holding this survey has expired, I shall be glad to learn when it is proposed that this survey will be carried out.
