Reverting to previous correspondence, I have to acquaint you that I have now received a report from the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff of their examination of the anchors and cables of this vessel.

Identification marks were only decipherable on two lengths of the cable on board, and duplicate certificates for the same are enclosed herewith. On the remaining 210 fathoms no marks were legible, and I regret that duplicate certificates cannot, therefore, be issued in respect of this cable.


With regard to the anchors I have to state that these were found in good order, and duplicate certificates are sent herewith.
