In reply to your letter of the 8th instant regarding the steamer "BRAVORE", I have to state that the anchors and cable of this vessel have now been examined. The cable is 240 fathoms x l. <sup>10-9</sup>16 and in good condition, and although evidence of the markings were found in all the lengths they were not sufficiently legible to be noted, except on two lengths which appeared to be marked L.P.H.CH. 18161.

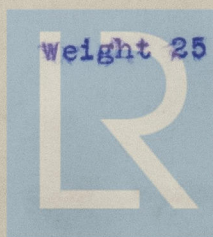
