Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 4th instant in which you make application for duplicate certificates of test in respect of the anchors and chain cables on board the steamer "BRAVORE", I have to inform you that the Committee are much averse to authorising the issue of duplicate certificates of test, but in the circumstances they are prepared to furnish the desired documents, subject to the anchors and cables being examined and reported upon as regards condition, identification marks, etc. by this Society's Surveyors, and subject to your giving the Society the usual letter of indemnity on the accompanying form.

The charge for duplicate certificates is 10/- per certificate, in addition to a moderate fee in respect of the services of the Society's Surveyors.

The Society's Surveyors at Cardiff are being requested to make the requisite examination with a view to the duplicate certificates of test being issued.
