Survey REPAIRS TO ENGINES AND BOILERS DUE TO DAMAGE THROUGH FIRE

The class is subject to the LP column being renewed at the first opportunity and propeller repaired at Owners' convenience.

On account of damage sustained by fire in No. 3 Shelter Deck, all electric cables and fittings in this space have been renewed. Steering engine also placed in order.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible to remain as CLASSED, subject as above.

A Special Survey became due 8.46 and a B.S. due 6.47. In a cablegram from the Lisbon Surveyors the Owners request a further extension of class for six months if temporary repairs are made.

Submitted for the consideration of the Committee. The B.S., however, should not be postponed more than two or three months.
