Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that the contents of your letter of the 15th instant regarding the case of the steamer "ALAMO" were read to the Classing Committee at their meeting yesterday.

Having regard to the fact that she is in heavily damaged condition they decided to suspend the class, so that we are inserting in the Register Book a notation of "Class Suspended" to the existing one of "In port damaged".

The purpose behind this decision was to make it clear that the Society will not grant class cover for any contemplated voyage to a repair port, and they are therefore unable to authorise you to issue any certificate such as that envisaged in the penultimate paragraph of your letter.
