in October, 1953, and the class was suspended with a thin black
line.

In reply to a letter regarding the overdue Boiler Survey and forthcoming
Special Survey due 6,55 the Valparaiso Surveyors now write:-

"With regards to the SRMC. due, I have to inform you
that this installation has been "withdrawn" from class. It is never
used and, so long as the present owners manage the vessel, it
never will be."

In the 1955/6 Register Book the RMC class will appear in parentheses,
but in view of the Valparaiso Surveyors statement that the Refrigerated Cargo Installation
will never be used by the present Owners, it is submitted that the vessel's name be
deleted from the Refrigerated Section of the forthcoming report.
