

The s.s. No.3 due 11-24 has been partly held by the examination of the bottom and rudder in dry dock, ranging of chain cables and examination of chain locker.

A letter has now been received from the Owners stating that the vessel is now classed with the Bureau Veritas and they do not see the usefulness of carrying out this Society's special survey No.3.

It is submitted a copy of the Owners' letter might be forwarded to the Boulogne Surveyor together with particulars of the portions of the survey already held and he should be requested to interview the Owners and explain what is necessary to complete the survey and ascertain definitely if they desire to withdraw the vessel's class.
