Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their Meeting to-day a communication received from the Society's Surveyor at Shanghai, from which it appears you have informed him that it is not your desire to maintain the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamers "MING-HAO" (ex "CHILDAR"), "FEI HU" (ex "DRUFAR") and "TAI-SHAN" (ex "TRAFALGAR"), and I am directed to say that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of the classes of the steamers "MING-HAO" and "FEI HU" the records of the freeboards assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates are thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
