Dear Sir,

With reference to Glasgow report No.37818 on the  
S. boilers Nos.605-7, built by Messrs. A.F.Craig & Co., I have to  
inform you that these boilers are now reported by the Society's  
Surveyors at Bristol to have been fitted on the new standard  
vessel "WAR MUSKET".

The completed First Entry reports have to-day  
received the consideration of the Committee, who have classed  
the vessel "100 AI", subject to a third bower anchor being  
supplied, with notations of "Lloyd's A. & C.P." and "LMC.7.18  
F.D.".

*The* proportion of the fee due for the survey of the  
boilers during construction amounts to £13.0.6d, and it is  
understood that the Bristol Surveyors have applied to the Boiler  
makers for this fee, on payment of which your account will be  
duly credited with the amount.
