Sir

With reference to my telegram of today's date concerning the reports on 5/8 ar musket & in explanation of the same I beg to inform you that the first entry report & certificate was sent off before I returned from Gloucester, the machinery reports & prepared plans etc & the progress reports were dispatched on my return & were sent to the General Post Office to be weighed & the money for the stamps was taken. The officials however refused to sell stamps as it was after nine & on returning to the General after procuring stamps, the parcel could not enter the letter box & the official at the telegraph counter refused to take same.

I much regret the delay.
