The class is subject to permanent repairs to leaking rivets in boundary angles from No. 6 D.B. tank at the next dry docking, and to indented shell plating (p & s) at the first convenient opportunity, also to (a bower anchor being supplied).

The OSLO Surveyors report in a letter dated 24.10.46 that they are in receipt of a letter from the Owner stating that this vessel will be classed with the Norske Veritas on her arrival at Marseilles next month (see also Oslo letters dated 5th and 12th of January, 1946).

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.
