In cases which have to be submitted to the Classing Committee "the endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—(Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.).

Duration of Survey..... When due.....

The class is subject to (a bower anchor (73 cwts.) and 45 fathoms of chain cable being supplied).

The Periodical Special Survey (C) became due 1.49.

The Owners requested an extension of 12 months for completion of Special Survey, but the COMMITTEE stipulated at their meeting 11.3.49 that a maximum of 6 months only could be granted.

The Owners, in a letter dated 26.3.49 forwarded by the Genoa Surveyor, state that they are unable to comply with the above conditions, and desire the vessel's class be discontinued.

This is submitted for the consideration of the COMMITTEE.
