In forwarding the enclosed First Entry Reports on the T.S. Motor Tanker "EMBANEF", I have to explain that the reason for the lapse of time between the last date of survey and the date of dispatch is due to the fact that the survey was completed at Batoum, where the vessel was loading for London.
