Maschinenfabrik Augsburg-Nürnberg A.G. survey during construction in their works at Augsburg two exhaust gas fired Vertical Tube Feed Water Heaters of 91 sq.meters heating surface each. These Feed Water Heaters have been ordered by Messrs. Handelsvertretung der U.d.S.S.R. of Berlin and are intended for the machinery of the M.V. No. 185 being under construction in the Yard of Messrs. Nicolaieff States Shipbuilding Co. "ANDRE MARTI" of Nicolaieff.

The Feed Water Heaters having been tested on the 23rd August 1927 by hydraulic pressure to 12 kgs. per sq.cm. showed no signs of weakness and were found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure. Working pressure not to exceed 6 Kgs. per sq.cm. Mark on Feed Water Heaters:—
