
The 2nd Special Survey No.2 became due in October, 1932, and the year of grace has been granted.

On the expiration of the year of grace, as the vessel was stated to be laid up indefinitely at Algiers, the Owners were asked to furnish the usual undertaking.

A letter has now been received from the Owners' London Agents in which they state that the vessel is not laid up at Algiers but is being used as a depot ship for the storage of oil for bunkering purposes. They further state that, after due consideration, it has been decided to allow the vessel's class to lapse.

The year of grace expired 10,33.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, 1st instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of Class at Owners' request.
