Dear Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 6th instant, respecting the second Special Survey No 2 of the S/S "FRANCUNION V", I beg to forward, herewith, a copy of the letter received from the Owners from which you will observe that this vessel, being intended for a non definite time ^{to remain} in the port of Algiers, they have decided to make no arrangement for this Inspection to be held.-

Having, on receipt of this letter, placed myself in communication with the Owners, I have been informed by them that the vessel is at present laid up in Algiers and, as this position is expected to remain unchanged for a certain time, two or three years perhaps, they intend to use her as a Store in the port of Algiers. In the circumstances, they do not desire to have any Survey held for classification, except in the event, which they consider possible, of her being again replaced in commission for sea trading, in which case, they added, they will make the necessary arrangements.
